## Invitation for Non-Profits: Apply for Transform386's Infrastructure and Mitigation Program

June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Volusia County has received Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to assist in recovery efforts from Hurricane Ian. \$50 million of this funding has been allocated for infrastructure projects with an additional \$42.9 million allocated for mitigation projects. These resources will be utilized to enhance Volusia County as a whole, underscoring dedication to ensure the safety, functionality, and long-term resiliency for the residents of Volusia County.

Non-Profit Organizations are encouraged to apply. The project proposal should contain a detailed budget breakdown that identifies non-CDBG-DR funding sources.

Additionally, applications must address seven scoring criteria:

- Leveraged funding (up to 20 pts)
- LMI-Area Benefit percentage (up to 20 pts)
- Level of Flood Risk Reduction (up to 20 pts)
- Quantity of Flood Risk Reduction (up to 15 pts)
- Cost Benefit Analysis (up to 10 pts)
- Environmental Impact (up to 10 pts)
- Ease of Permitting (up to 5 pts)
