General Updates

✱ Homeowner Recovery

91 homeowners signed grant agreements this past quarter, 57 projects began construction, and 25 homes were completed as recovery efforts continue.

✱ Infrastructure & Mitigation

The Volusia County Council approved nearly \$50 million for 14 significant flood mitigation and infrastructure projects across the community.

✱ Multi-Family Housing

Two multi-family projects advanced this past quarter, with all environmental reviews submitted to HUD for approval.

Infrastructure

\$50 Million for Flood Mitigation Projects Across the County Approved!

The Volusia County Council has approved nearly \$50 million to move forward with 14 major flood mitigation and infrastructure projects across Volusia County. These projects are federally funded through our infrastructure program and supported by an additional \$30 million in matching funds from local applicants, bringing the total investment to about \$80 million.

These projects will strengthen the county's resilience against flooding and improve critical infrastructure across the community. This investment represents a step toward building a safer, more resilient future. The funding will help protect homes, businesses, and roadways from future storm impacts.
